- Avoid the use of unfair competitive practices and the violation of Federal Anti-Trust laws and related statutes.
- Assist one's fellow photographers by sharing knowledge with them and encouraging them individually and collectively to achieve and maintain the highest standards of quality in producing a photographic product or providing photographic services.
- Recognize the authority of this Association in all matters relating to the interpretation of this Code.

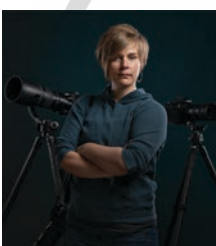

Jeff is a PPA International Approved Juror, a Vatican Approved Photographer and the Past President of the Society of XXV. In March of 2023, Jeff completed his role as President of the Professional Photographers of America and served as the Chairman of the Board. Jeff was just awarded PPA's Honorary Master of Photography at Imaging USA 2023. In 2018 he was awarded the Imaging Excellence award from PPA. In 2012 Jeff and Carolle purchased a building with a storybook past in the small village of Bedford, NH. Their studio was featured in Professional Photographer Magazine in 2008, 2013 and 2019. They are also authors of two titles for Amherst Media. "Lighting on Location" and "Profit Building For The Professional Photographer."



James Flachsbarth | M.PHOTOGRAPHER, M.WED. PHOTOGRAPHER, CPP

James began his career as a wedding photographer in 2012 after founding Flax Studios on the coast of Maine. His business grew to success quickly and to date he has captured over 180 weddings. James' list of accomplishments includes having two of the top 10 wedding images in the 2020 IPC and winning a 2nd Place Grand Imaging Award. He has also been awarded 2 Gold, 2 Silver, and 3 Bronze medals since his first case in 2016 at IPC. In December 2020, "Ghosts Of The Past" was featured on the cover of Professional Photographer Magazine, and "Sunset Pirouette" was featured on the June 2022 issue. As a member of the Maine PPA, he has been awarded the coveted Win Tracy Maine Photographer of the Year Trophy, Wedding Photographer of the Year Award (2x), Fine Art Photographer of the Year, Reportage Photographer of the Year, Landscape Photographer of the Year, Best In Show Award, Client Image Award, ASP State Elite Award, Best B+W Award (2x), Judges Choice Award (4x), and all of this since earning the First Time Entrant Award in 2016. More recently, he was a Grand Imaging Award Finalist in the 2021 Northeast District with two top 10 images in the wedding category. Beyond this, he was awarded Honorable Mention in the B+W category in the Maine Photography Show, and has been featured in multiple publications in print and online.
